Mr. Skebey,

I have completed a cursory review of the Hilliard Expansion Projects Erosion and Sediment Control Plan dated February 4, 2019 and received on March 4, 2019. Based upon my review of the above information, I believe the proposed erosion and sediment control plan is consistent with the City of Elmira's Stormwater Management Control Ordinance. This acceptance is based on the following conditions.

1. Silt and/or sediment shall not be allowed to leave the project site, including tracking onto public streets. Erosion and sediment controls, outlined in the accepted Erosion & Sediment Control Plan, shall be implemented and maintained to ensure this purpose. If silt, sediment, and/or dust are found to be leaving the site, the Owner (or their contractor) shall take immediate actions to correct the situation.
2. One set of the Final Erosion and Sediment Control Plan must be on-site at all times during construction and site stabilization.
