Checked Food Temperatures- Meat Balls- 210 degrees F, Sausage- 170 degrees F, Meat Sauce- 190 degrees F, Hot Dogs- 165 degrees F, Nacho Cheese stored in dispensing machine- +160 degrees F. Monitoring thermometers available inside cold- held refrigerated storage units- cold potentially hazardous (TCS) foods were stored at less than 45 degrees F. Operator has both numerical and digital thermometers for checking cooked potentially hazardous foods.
