Food from unapproved source, spoiled, adulterated on premises.

Inspector Findings

Observed frozen liquid condensate waste in direction contact individual serving size bags of (~15 lbs) potato chips in an open box in walk-in freezer directly under condenser. Observed frozen liquid condensate on several closed boxes of food as well- food is bagged inside of boxes. Manager voluntarily discarded potato chips that were in opened box. Unopened boxes with frozen liquid condensate on them were voluntarily discarded. Observed frozen liquid condensate on condenser as well as walls and ceiling in walk-in freezer. Discussed relocating all food to prevent contamination or covering food until condensate problem fixed. CORRECTED.

IMPROPER SANITARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS.

ITEM # 12C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Plumbing and sinks not properly sized, installed, maintained; equipment and floors not properly drained

Inspector Findings

Observed frozen liquid condensate waste on condenser as well as walls and ceiling of entire walk-in freezer. During previous inspection, problem was localized to condenser area and has now expanded throughout entire freezer. Interview with manager indicated that she was unaware of previous inspection and did not believe service representative had been in to look at freezer. Time table of correction 3/15/16.
