Visit requested by director of physical facilities to evaluate progress of proposed temporary kitchen inside gymnasium due to ongoing renovations in and around cafeteria and kitchen. Per previous discussions with facilities director and district food service manager, renovations are to continue into February 2018, and temporary kitchen will be used to feed students until then. The food will be prepared at Edison cafeteria and be transported under temperature control, if potentially hazardous food (45F or less or 140F or greater) to Cohen, where it will be hot and cold-held and served. Dishware will be cleaned at Edison, also. Per field visit, there appears to be adequate hot and cold holding equipment at temporary kitchen. There are two sinks for hand washing. The floor has yet to be sealed to ensure it is non-absorbent, smooth and easily cleanable. Some bare wood surfaces, which will also need to be made smooth, easily cleanable and non-absorbent, were observed under some equipment. Half of gym used exclusively for food service and consumption. Other half of gym will be used for phys ed and will be walled off with floor to ceiling door. Facilities director was advised to contact CCHD to request pre-operational inspection several days prior to first day of school (day of first use) to ensure code compliance.
