Facility was opened for service of food prior to conducting pre-operational inspection. Facility permit states that a pre-operational inspection is required prior to opening seasonal use Halfway House.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Conducted pre-operational phone conference with chef. Per Scott, all foods except pre-packaged snacks and hot dogs, which are cooked on a roller in the Halfway House, all food items are prepared in the main kitchen and taken to the Halfway House on a daily basis. All wares are washed in the main kitchen. Discussed need for probe thermometer to verify hot and cold holding temperatures at Halfway House, recommended obtaining digital thermometers since calibration is not typically required. Also discussed prevention of barehand contact with ready to eat items, such as hot dog buns and excluding ill food workers, such as those with diarrhea, vomiting, fever, yellowing of the skin or eyes, infected cuts, or sore throat.
