Soda and dispensing equipment stored under waste line in basement. Operator stated he would relocate equipment. Discussed installation of ceiling above soda equipment. Time table of correction 8/20/17.

Comments

Facility will use sink in kitchen as mop sink and one bay of 3 bay sink at bar for hand washing. Facility is offering a very limited menu at this time. Operator has plans to remodel kitchen in the future to expand the menu. Facility will be required to install a separate mop sink at that time. Discussed submitting plans to CCHD prior starting remodeling project. Observed sanitizer (Quaternary Ammonia) and facility test strips. Reviewed that sanitizing solution to be 200ppm. Observed facility's probe thermometer- discussed with staff and operator that digital thermometers are acceptable replacements for probe thermometer.
