FOOD NOT PROTECTED IN GENERAL

ITEM # 8A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).
Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.
Code Requirements
Food not protected during storage, preparation, display, transportation and service, from potential sources of contamination (e.g., food uncovered, mislabeled, stored on floor, missing or inadequate sneeze guards, food containers double stacked)

Inspector Findings
Some food containers found uncovered inside kitchen refrigerator- Corrected.

ITEM # 8B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).
Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.
Code Requirements
In use food dispensing utensils improperly stored

Inspector Findings
Inside kitchen sandwich unit- handle of ice cream scoop found in contact with lettuce leaves- Cook removed scoop handle from lettuce leaves and discarded top layer of lettuce leaves- Corrected. Instructed Cook that handles of utensils and equipment must not be stored in contact with other foods unless staff are using plastic gloves.

IMPROPER SANITARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS.

ITEM # 12D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Toilet facilities inadequate, inconvenient, dirty, in disrepair, toilet paper missing, not self-closing doors, missing hand wash signs

Inspector Findings

Employee rest room door is not self-closing in rear kitchen by walk-in cooler.

IMPROPER GARBAGE AND RUBBISH DISPOSAL

ITEM # 13A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Adequate, leakproof, non-absorbent, vermin-proof, covered containers not provided where needed

Inspector Findings

Lid of dumpster off parking lot open (dumpster full)- per Operator, dumpster scheduled for pick-up within 24 hrs.

IMPROPER CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES.

ITEM # 15A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Floors, walls, ceilings, not smooth, properly constructed, in disrepair, dirty surfaces

Inspector Findings

Floor surfaces below kitchen cook line equipment/ stove- dirty, greasy surfaces.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Checked UV disinfection equipment during inspection- equipment was operational, meter was reading 71%. Did not take water sample during inspection. Discussed routine calibration of numerical thermometers used to checked hot potentially hazardous (TCS) foods with Cook during inspection. Sanitizer test kits available for checking dish machine. Discussed routine hand washing and proper use of gloves during inspection(Cook was using plastic gloves properly during inspection). A Time Table of Compliance Date of June 20, 2017 has been established to correct the remaining violations listed above. A re-inspection will be conducted after this date to determine compliance.
