Door gaskets of walk-in freezer in disrepair.

Inspector Findings

Interior lip of ice machine not clean.

Comments

Observed quaternary ammonia sanitizing solution at 200 ppm per facility's test strips. Hand wash station was stocked with adequate supplies such as soap, and paper towels. Advised to have lightbulbs in back walk in cooler area to be brighter. Discussed ill worker policy. Advised immediate placement of leftover pizza to be donated from buffet into commercial refrigeration/freezer to rapidly cool. Advised to keep shredded cheese and other potentially hazardous foods in salad bar to be placed at lower levels in wells, in order to help maintain temperature of foods at or below 45 F.
