ITEM # 12C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 2 TIME(S).

Code Requirements

Plumbing and sinks not properly sized, installed, maintained; equipment and floors not properly drained

Inspector Findings

1. Newly replaced indirect drain under hand-wash sink in back area does not have adequate air gap.
2. Flexible condensate waste water line observed in walk-in cooler draining from condenser unit into plastic bucket on floor. Discussed plumbing condensate waste line to indirect drain. Both violations to be corrected prior to start of 2018 season.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Reinspection conducted to follow up on violations observed during previous inspection. Item 8E (thermometer lacking in 2 door commercial cooler) and Item 11A (facility lacking test strips for chlorinated sanitizing solutions) have been corrected. During time of reinspection sanitarians observed cooling of cheese sauce and meat sauce that had been cooked and hot held for hot dogs. Discussed changing status of facility from medium risk to high risk facility due to cooling of potentially hazardous food (PHF/TCS) items. Manager stated 10/30/17 was the last day of their season and will reopen in March of 2018. Discussed informing CCHD of any renovations that may occur during the offseason and to contact CCHD with any questions.
