IMPROPER COOLING AND REFRIGERATED STORAGE OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

ITEM # 5C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). PUBLIC HEALTH HAZARD

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not stored under refrigeration except during necessary preparation or approved precooling procedures (room temperature storage).

Inspector Findings

At 11:30am, observed 60 turkey and cheese subs wrapped in foil on picnic table in a foil pan at temperature of 63-64dF (temperature of actual turkey and cheese in sub). Interview indicated that when subs were delivered, staff took temperature and recorded it at 54dF and per site staff delivery staff stated "temperature was high due to bread and the turkey and cheese were still at the right temperature and stated they would deliver them in a cooler in the future". Staff contacted distribution site who returned with cereal and voluntarily discarded the subs. Discussed with both delivery and site staff that when a temperature above 45dF is observed at time of delivery, then food needs to be returned. CORRECTED.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Observed milk stored in cooler ice at temperature of 44dF. Discussed use of utensils to scoop mixed berries into single service cups. Observed staff washing hands at temporary hand wash station and putting on gloves.
