Individual bags of commercially prepackaged baby carrots, provided in bagged lunches, found adulterated. Observed slimy coating on carrots in bags and children complaining carrots tasting bad. Workers collected all bags of baby carrots and discarded them. Workers stated they would contact facility's site that prepares their lunches, Elmira City School District (ECSD), to inform them of issue with baby carrots. CORRECTED

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Observed workers taking temperature of bagged lunches using digital probe thermometer and 2 milk cartons. Workers found temperature of milk was 40F and recorded in temperature log. Observed disposable table cloths used on surfaces where children have their meals.
