ITEM # 10B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Non-food contact surfaces and equipment are improperly designed, constructed, installed, maintained (equipment not readily accessible for cleaning, surface not smooth finish)

Inspector Findings

Observed cardboard lining shelves in dry storage area of kitchen. Surfaces are not smooth, easily cleanable, or non-absorbent.

INADEQUATE INSECT/RODENT CONTROL

ITEM # 14B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Effective measures not used to control entrance (rodent-, insect-proof construction). Harborage areas available for rodents, insects and other vermin

Inspector Findings

Observed rear exit door in kitchen propped open. Operator closed door during reinspection. CORRECTED

IMPROPER CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES.

ITEM # 15A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Floors, walls, ceilings, not smooth, properly constructed, in disrepair, dirty surfaces

Inspector Findings

Ceiling tiles missing above walk-in cooler unit during time of inspection.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Reinspection conducted to follow up on time table of correction (TTOC) for violations observed from previous inspection. Item 8A - buckets of food observed on the floor, Item 8D - potentially contaminated bags used to line wall behind 3 bay sink, Item 11A - facility lacking test strips to evaluate bleach solution, Item 11C - sanitizer not used to sanitize dirty dishes, Item 11D - dirty surfaces on slotted metal shelves in walk-in cooler, Item 12D - toilet room door propped open, Item 15A - dry wall in disrepair, walls in cooler dirty surfaces, dirty floor throughout facility, blue bags covering wall behind 3 bay sink, and Item 15B - nonfunctioning light fixture in rear storage area all have been corrected. All other violations given TTOC for 10/25/17. Observed several previously cooked food items cooling in walk-in cooler at a rate that will meet the required cooling schedule. Discussed cooling in pans at depths of no more than 4 inches.
