Each item found in violation is reported below along with the code requirement.

IMPROPER COOLING AND REFRIGERATED STORAGE OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

ITEM # 5A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or below 45oF during cold holding, except smoked fish not kept at or below 38oF during cold holding.

Inspector Findings

At ~10:40am, observed the following in the cold holding sandwich line; 1/6th plastic insert with lid containing a ~4 inch stack (~1 lb) of sliced provolone cheese, from the bottom of the stack upwards to the middle of the stack (~2 inches) was temped at 45F, from the middle of the stack to the top of the stack was temped at 46-56F. Also observed a 1/3rd plastic insert with lid containing a ~4 inch stack (~1lb) of sliced pepper jack cheese and ~4 inch stack (~1lb) of sliced American cheese stored net to each other in same insert, from the bottom of the stack upwards to the middle of the stack (~2 inches) was temped at 45F, from the middle of the stack to the top of the stack was temped at 46-56F. These 2 inserts were stored next to each other in the sandwich make unit. The cheese was stored ~1 inch below the top of the insert. These inserts were stored in such a manner in which a support bar intended to be used in between the inserts was not present. Lack of use of this bar prevents the units ability to hold cold air in. All other items in this make unit temped at 45F or below. Interview indicated that these cheeses were placed in this unit less than 2 hours prior (~9 am). Operator relocated the top 2 inches of both stacks of cheese to a separate cold holding unit and was instructed to only store 2 inches of cheese in these inserts until a new support bar was located and used. - corrected.

FOOD NOT PROTECTED IN GENERAL

ITEM # 8E WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Accurate thermometers not available or used to evaluate refrigerated or heated storage temperatures

Inspector Findings

thermometer lacking in 2 door cold holding unit across from cold holding sandwich make unit. The 2 door cold holding unit contains phf sliced meats and cheeses. Operator placed therm. in cold holding unit - corrected.

IMPROPER CLEANING, WASHING AND SANITIZING OF EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS.

ITEM # 11D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Non food contact surfaces of equipment not clean

Inspector Findings

observed dirty surfaces (door, door gasket, wall, shelf) inside 2 door cold holding unit across from cold holding sandwich make unit.

IMPROPER SANITARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS.

ITEM # 12C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Plumbing and sinks not properly sized, installed, maintained; equipment and floors not properly drained

Inspector Findings

leak observed under drain line of 3 bay sink in rear prep area. Bucket observed underneath leaking drain line catching water, water observed in bucket.

ITEM # 12D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Toilet facilities inadequate, inconvenient, dirty, in disrepair, toilet paper missing, not self-closing doors, missing hand wash signs

Inspector Findings

covered waste receptacle lacking in ladies toilet room. Main garbage can for ladies toilet room does not have a lid, garbage can in stall 1 has a lid, garbage can in stall 2 does does not have a lid.
