Food from unapproved source, spoiled, adulterated on premises.

Inspector Findings

Metal hose of soda gun machine located next to wall in bar area not clean. Observed build up on hose. Hose observed in contact with ice used for drinks in ice bay next to wall in bar area. Hose moved to side of ice bay and out of contact with ice. Manager voluntarily discarded ice that had been in contact with soda gun hose. Discussed cleaning hose with sanitizing wiping cloth on regular basis. CORRECTED

IMPROPER CLEANING, WASHING AND SANITIZING OF EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS.

ITEM # 11B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Wiping cloths dirty, not stored properly in sanitizing solutions

Inspector Findings

Wiping cloth observed in bar area's wiping cloth bucket with inadequate levels (100 ppm) of quaternary ammonia sanitizer in solution. Required level of quaternary sanitizer in a solution is 200-400 ppm. Staff emptied wiping cloth bucket and added new solution with adequate levels (300 ppm) of sanitizer. CORRECTED

ITEM # 11D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Non food contact surfaces of equipment not clean

Inspector Findings

Metal hose of soda gun machine located next to wall in bar area not clean. Observed build up on hose. Hose observed in contact with ice used for drinks in ice bay next to wall in bar area. Hose moved to side of ice bay and out of contact with ice. Manager voluntarily discarded ice that had been in contact with soda gun hose. Discussed cleaning hose with sanitizing wiping cloth on regular basis. CORRECTED

Comments

Observed uncovered, metal sheet tray of chicken wings cooling in walk-in cooler at a rate that will meet the approved cooling schedule. Per manager, chicken wings are baked to 165F and placed in walk-in to cool and are to be reheated in deep fryer as ordered. Observed adequate levels of chlorine (100 ppm) used as sanitizer in facility's dish washing machine and observed facility's test strips for testing both chlorine and quaternary ammonia sanitizer levels. Observed several items thawing on racks in the walk-in cooler. Temperatures of all cold held items in all make units and other refrigeration units found at temperatures of 45F or less. Observed working digital probe thermometer.
