Hot, cold running water not provided, pressure inadequate

Inspector Findings

No hot or cold running water observed during time of field visit. Operator stated the town of Big Flats has yet to turn on water due to low temperatures at night. Operator to contact town office to have water turned on for 2018 season and will contact CCHD when water is back on.

IMPROPER CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES.

ITEM # 15B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).
All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.
Code Requirements
Lighting and ventilation inadequate, fixtures not shielded, dirty ventilation hoods, ductwork, filters, exhaust fans

Inspector Findings

Observed 2 light fixtures with lights not functioning in back storage area and all light bulbs in back storage area not properly shielded.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Field visit conducted to inspect facility prior to opening for 2018 season. Observed one freezer properly functioning and 5 others not yet functioning as they had not yet been plugged due to pre-seasonal cleaning. Observed working digital thermometer, bleach used for sanitizing utensils and surfaces, and test strips used to evaluate levels of chlorine in bleach-based sanitizing solutions. Operator stated facility may switch to quaternary ammonia as the primary sanitizer and discussed purchasing the appropriate test strips for evaluating levels of quaternary ammonia. Operator to contact CCHD when ready for preoperational inspection.
