### Comments

Inspection occurred at Chemung County Fair. No violations observed. Mobile unit had functioning digital thermometer. At time of inspection, hotdog roller was removed (was present during pre-op) as hot dogs were not being offered. No potentially hazardous time/temperature controlled for safety foods (phf/tcs) observed in mobile unit. Smoothies are made using only non-phf/tcs ingredients. Water was operating at time of inspection and was used for hand washing. Hand washing supplies included soap, hot water, and paper towels. Facility has sanitizer (quaternary ammonia) and test strips available to evaluate concentration of sanitizer.
