**IMPROPER HOT HOLDING OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.**

**ITEM # 6A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or above 140oF during hot holding.

Inspector Findings

Observed 7 individual portions of ham slices and 3 sausage patties in hot top center hot holding unit at temperature of 122-135dF. Staff stated that particular unit does not seem to hot hold correctly all the time. All other foods in other inserts found at 155dF or higher. Discussed requirement to hot hold time and temperature control for safety (TCS/PHF) food at 140dF or higher and not storing tcs food in top center insert unless able to hot hold at required temperature. Recommended storing non-tcs food such as cooked crispy bacon in center hot holding unit instead of ham slices and sausage patties. Staff voluntarily discarded ham slices and sausage patties. CORRECTED.

**FOOD NOT PROTECTED IN GENERAL**

**ITEM # 8A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Food not protected during storage, preparation, display, transportation and service, from potential sources of contamination (e.g., food uncovered, mislabeled, stored on floor, missing or inadequate sneeze guards, food containers double stacked)

Inspector Findings

Observed boxes of food stored on floor in walk-in freezer. Discussed requirement to store all food a minimum of 6 inches off the floor.

## IMPROPER SANITARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS.

ITEM # 12D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

### Code Requirements

Toilet facilities inadequate, inconvenient, dirty, in disrepair, toilet paper missing, not self-closing doors, missing hand wash signs

### Inspector Findings

Mens restroom closed (sign on door) during inspection. Interview indicated that handle on toilet was broken by a patron this morning. Parts were being obtained and toilet would be fixed today. All patrons to use woman's restroom until men's toilet fixed.

### Comments

Observed staff wearing gloves while preparing ready to eat sandwiches. Observed sliced cheese in top of cold holding make unit at temperature of 42dF. Observed sanitizer (Quaternary ammonia) in 3 bay sink at 400ppm and in wiping cloth buckets at 200ppm per facility's test strips. Discussed hand washing and ill food worker policy.
