Food not protected during storage, preparation, display, transportation and service, from potential sources of contamination (e.g., food uncovered, mislabeled, stored on floor, missing or inadequate sneeze guards, food containers double stacked)

Inspector Findings

Inside walk-in cooler, small box of prescription drug (Victoza) improperly stored on storage shelf with other food items- Operator removed prescription drug from shelf with other food items during inspection- Corrected

**IMPROPER CLEANING, WASHING AND SANITIZING OF EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS.**

**ITEM # 11B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Wiping cloths dirty, not stored properly in sanitizing solutions

Inspector Findings

No test kit available (quaternary ammonia) for checking strength of wiping cloth solution- Operator to obtain proper test kit for checking wiping cloth sanitizer solution- inspector checked sanitizer during inspection- +200 ppm .

Comments

Operator to obtain sanitizer test kit within 24 hrs. to verify strength of quaternary ammonia solution for wiping cloths (facility has test kit for checking chlorine solution). Discussed proper cooling of leftover potentially hazardous (TCS) foods during inspection. Numerical thermometers available for checking cooked potentially hazardous foods- no hot foods under being hot-held during inspection. Checked final rinse temperature of dish machine- +190 dF (per gauge). Staff were observed properly using plastic gloves during inspection. Will conduct a HACCP training exercise with kitchen staff later in year.
