Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments: Obtained a free chlorine residual of 1.2 mg/L from KCWT. Provided food safety training with volunteers at facility. Reviewed cold holding temperature (45F or less) and hot holding temperatures (140F or more). Discussed use of thermometers to monitor food temperatures during cooking, cooling, and hot or cold holding. Discussed cooling procedures (shallow depths without lids in refrigeration) to meet cooling schedule of 120-70 in 2 hours then 70-45 in an additional 4 hours. Discussed reheating previously cooked and cooled foods to a temperature of 165F within 2 hours. Provided danger zone temperature guide, cooling and reheating of time and temperature control for safety/potentially hazardous food (TCS/PHF) brochure and food safety summary sheet. Reviewed foods that were tcs/phf and required to be cold held at 45F or less. Recommended storing foods in a manner to allow cold air circulation in the refrigerator and freezer.
