**IMPROPER HOT HOLDING OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.**

**ITEM # 6A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or above 140oF during hot holding.

Inspector Findings

At ~2:40pm, observed 2 slices of potentially hazardous food/time temperature control for safety (PHF/TCS) sausage with pepperoni (cooked pepperoni is non-PHF/TCS) pizza and 2 slices of PHF/TCS chopped garlic pizza with no discard times assigned to either type of pizza. Facility has hot holding waiver for all PHF/TCS pizzas, calzones, and stombolis and must mark all items with a 4 hour discard time from time they are finished cooking and placed out on display/service counter. Discussed with manager that all pizzas containing PHF/TCS items, such as cooked vegetables and sausage or ham, must be marked with 4 hour discard times and discarded at or before said time. Manager voluntarily discarded the slices observed above as discard times had not be assigned. CORRECTED.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Discussed properly marking 4 hour discard time for PHF/TCS shredded mozzarella cheese when bins are removed from walk-in cooler to be used to make pizzas. Discussed using notepad to mark mozzarella cheese discard times. Discussed working in small manageable quantities of PHF/TCS ingredients that aren't on the cold holding waiver such as uncooked, sliced pepperoni or sausage. Per manager, PHF/TCS toppings are used at pizza making station and placed back into walk-in cooler after 15-20 minutes of use to prevent items from reaching temperatures above 45F.
