IMPROPER COOLING AND REFRIGERATED STORAGE OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

ITEM # 5A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or below 45°F during cold holding, except smoked fish not kept at or below 38°F during cold holding.

Inspector Findings

At ~9:30am, observed 3 unopened plastic containers of regular cream cheese, 2 opened containers of regular cream cheese, 2 open containers of chive and onion cream cheese, and 2 open containers of honey walnut cream cheese on service table with discard times lacking on containers and in facility's logbook. Facility has cold holding waiver for time/temperature control for safety (TCS) cream cheese, which requires the 4-hour discard time be marked on each container and in logbook. Manager stated cream cheese was delivered at 6:20am placed on table for service. Sanitarian explained that since discard times were not recorded as agreed upon in cold holding waiver it would be considered a violation of the waiver. Employee voluntarily discarded cream cheese. Discussed methods for cold holding cream cheese by use of ice or miniature refrigeration unit. Discussed writing discard time on bottom of plastic containers when left on table for service. Discussed storing some container of cream cheese in facility's miniature refrigeration unit until need on service table. CORRECTED.

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments

Observed patrons using napkins and single use utensils to take bagels from box to prevent barehand contact. Observed garbage can set out for patrons to discard garbage properly. Observed non-TCS single serving creamer cups used for coffee on service table.
