ITEM # 8E WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

Code Requirements

Accurate thermometers not available or used to evaluate refrigerated or heated storage temperatures

Inspector Findings

Digital thermometer on bottom of hot holding cabinet reading inaccurate. Facility has obtained a new analog thermometer for hot holding cabinet but temperature range does not start until 150F. Discussed that thermometer needs to read temperatures below 150F as hot holding temperature is 140F or greater. Discussed that with current thermometer, staff are able unable to determine if unit is hot holding correctly or not. Owner stated a new thermometer was being obtained by co-owner who was at the store. Time table of correction 7/18/18.

IMPROPER GARBAGE AND RUBBISH DISPOSAL

ITEM # 13B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Garbage storage areas not properly constructed or maintained, creating a nuisance

Inspector Findings

Observed a full 5 gallon bucket underneath smoker collecting grease outside of building. Observed a large grease spill on ground underneath smoker and spread out into driveway. Interview with owner indicated that grease from smoker is collected in buckets and emptied into external grease collection container at back of driveway/building. Owner stated the grease spill under smoker into the driveway was a result of her using the hose to clean off the concrete pad the other day and dumping bucket accidentally. Discussed requirement to dispose of full grease buckets to prevent overflowing or full buckets being left to attract pests. Discussed DEC's recommendation for cleaning up contaminated soil and disposing of at landfill. Time table of correction 11/17/18.

Comments

Visit conducted to investigate complaint. Discussed with owner that permit expires on July 15th and paperwork and fee need to be provided to CCHD for new permit issuance if facility planned to open on July 16, 2018. Operator stated she would get all required paperwork and fee delivered to CCHD by next business day.
