**ITEM # 1C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Home canned goods, or canned goods from unapproved processor found on premises

Inspector Findings

Observed four pint glass jars of home canned product containing hot pepper sauces. Also observed one pint jar of home canned product containing minced garlic and one jelly jar of whole gloves of garlic in oil. Three jars (2 pepper sauces and 1 garlic) had broken seals. All products were found in 2 door commercial refrigeration unit by grill. Advised operator to store home canned goods off premise. Reduced oxygen environment created with canned goods or other vacuum packaging is not permissible in food service facilities without an approved waiver. Operator voluntarily removed from facility. CORRECTED

**FOOD NOT PROTECTED IN GENERAL**

**ITEM # 8A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).**

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Food not protected during storage, preparation, display, transportation and service, from potential sources of contamination (e.g., food uncovered, mislabeled, stored on floor, missing or inadequate sneeze guards, food containers double stacked)

Inspector Findings

Two cases of dry pasta observed being stored on floor in dry goods area.

## IMPROPER SANITARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS.

ITEM # 12C WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Plumbing and sinks not properly sized, installed, maintained; equipment and floors not properly drained

Inspector Findings

Observed soda waste lines going through drink ice bins at bar. Discussed that waste lines should be plumbed into indirect drains under bins. Operator removed waste lines and draining into buckets until they are able to obtain longer waste lines to plumb into indirect drain. Time table of correction 4/25/18

ITEM # 12D WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the violation item are IN violation.

Code Requirements

Toilet facilities inadequate, inconvenient, dirty, in disrepair, toilet paper missing, not self-closing doors, missing hand wash signs

Inspector Findings

Mens bathroom door propped open during inspection. Discussed with operator door is to be closed during hours of operation.

Comments

Observed accurate digital thermometer. Discussed cooling procedures for cheese sauce for macaroni and cheese. Operator stated he cools the sauce in a long shallow pan in walk-in cooler. Observed soups cooling in walk-in cooler in same method. Discussed cooling without a lid. Discussed storage of utensils at breakfast buffet. Observed UV disinfectant reading of 89%. Floor tile in front of ice machine has been replaced from previous inspection.
