NO CRITICAL VIOLATIONS REPORTED

POOR SANITARY DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION OF EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS.

ITEM #10B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the item are violations.

Code Requirements: Non-food contact surfaces and equipment are improperly designed, constructed, installed, maintained (equipment not readily accessible for cleaning, surface not smooth finish)

Inspector Findings: Observed duct tape lining shelf in stand up freezer storing fried food products near sandwich make unit. Observed duct tape lining outside surfaces of walk-in cooler. Advised removing duct tape from surfaces as they do not provide a smooth, and easily cleanable surface. Discussed placing sealed or painted wood on area of duct tape along outside surfaces of walk-in cooler. Time table of correction (TTOC) set for 9/27/18.

IMPROPER CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES.

ITEM #15B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

All or parts of the item are violations.

Code Requirements: Lighting and ventilation inadequate, fixtures not shielded, dirty ventilation hoods, ductwork, filters, exhaust fans

Inspector Findings: Observed non-functioning light in walk-in cooler. Light switch located on outside of cooler has been removed. Per owner, wiring of light is abnormal and unable to be corrected. Owner has placed batter powered lantern in cooler stored on top shelf between food. Lantern must be opened by a free hand to expose light source. Discussed purchasing a battery powered push to operate style light to place in ceiling of walk-in cooler to allow adequate lighting and safe handling if worker hands are full. Time table for correction set for 9/27/18

Additional Information Collected During Inspection

Comments: At time of re-inspection a HACCP exercise was conducted. Violation 10B- Cardboard lining bottom shelf of prep table underneath slicer has been corrected. No other items were evaluated at time of inspection.
